Discover the rich history, unique design features & vigilant operations that make the Cape Cod Canal the safe & viable navigable waterway it is today. View real-time radar, camera & computer images of the Canal, transmitted live from the Central Marine Traffic Control System. 30 minutes.

Tuesdays CANAL KIDS 10am

Join Canal Park Rangers for fun and educational programs designed for kids ages 6-10. Explore different aspects of the canal each week with hands-on activities & games. Topics vary from 'What do Park Rangers do?" to marine life to water safety to engineering & more. Low Tide Exploration August 16

10am

Join a Park Ranger for a walk along the shoreline at the Canal's east end. During this 3/4-mile walk, we'll explore life along the beach, focusing on the intertidal zone. Discover how this area has changed and continues to change, and how the plants and animals adapt to living in such extremes

Bike Hike August 23 9am

Learn about the Canal while riding your bicycle alongside the waterway. Cape Cod Canal Park Rangers or volunteers will ride with you, share interesting stories and images, and point out many unique features of the Canal.
