7/20 – Fascinating Flood Journey

Meet the rangers at the Ranger Station (log cabin) in Elm Brook Park at 1:00. During this program the ranger will discuss the impacts of the most resent floods. Visitors will be able to see how much water was impounded during flood events and where are the water is stored.
