This errata sheet provides the following revisions to the Final Feasibility Study, Former Cape Poge Little Neck Bomb Target Munitions Response Area.

Errata #1: Page 5-7, Section 5.2.3.1, and Page 5-9, Section 5.2.4.1

Replace “The vegetation removed would be disposed of on-site after chipping.” **with** “Disposal of removed vegetation will be coordinated with TTOR and USACE subject matter experts during the development of the remedial action work plan to ensure the habitat is not detrimentally affected.”

Errata #2: Page 5-10, Section 5.2.4.1, and Page 5-13, Section 5.3.3.1

Add the sentence “The Five Year Review will also evaluate the success of vegetation mitigation activities.” **following this statement.** “A Five-Year Review will be conducted to confirm the project RAO of protecting recreational users, visitors, and workers at the MRS from explosive hazards associated with MEC exposure in the top three feet of subsurface soil or sediment during intrusive activities and by dune erosion was achieved.”
