## **Agencies to hold public information meeting on Wind Farm EIS status**

**CONCORD, Mass.** – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will host a public meeting on the status of the Cape Wind windfarm proposal on Thursday, Nov. 21 in Bourne, Mass.

The purpose of the meeting is to provide the public with an update on the current status of the Windfarm Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and state Environmental Impact Review (EIR). Various federal, state and local agencies will attend to answer questions on their areas of expertise in the environmental review process.

The meeting is open to all interested individuals, groups, and agencies, and will be held on Thursday, Nov. 21 from 4-7 p.m. in the Upper Cape Cod Regional Technical School cafeteria, located at 220 Sandwich Road in Bourne, MA.

Information tables/stations will be available for people to visit and ask one-on-one questions of the various agencies and groups involved (i.e. Federal Aviation Administration, Massachusetts Coastal Zone Management and Environmental Policy Act Office, Cape Wind Associates, LLC, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and others).
