The District Engineer has received a permit application to conduct work in waters of the United States from Patrick Brennan, Commodore, Marshfield Yacht Club, located at 11 Ridge Road, Marshfield, Massachusetts. Dredge work is proposed in the South River at 11 Ridge Road, Marshfield, Massachusetts, and disposal of the dredged material is proposed at Rexhame Beach at 325 Standish Street, Marshfield, Massachusetts.

The work involves adding two 3-foot x 35-foot finger floats for dinghies at the beginning of C Dock; and maintenance and improvement dredging of approximately 8,800 cubic yards from a 68,040 square foot (SF) area. The work in Area 1 involves dredging 5,800 cubic yards (CY) from a 44,260 SF area. This area was previously dredged to -4 mean low water (MLW) and would be dredged to -5 MLW. The work in Area 2 involves dredging 958 CY from a 7,930 SF area. This area was previously dredged to -5 MLW and would again be dredged to -5 MLW. The work in Area 3 involves dredging 2042 CY from a 15,850 SF area. This area was previously dredged to -4 MLW and would be dredged to -5 MLW. A total of 7,300 cubic yards of well-sorted sand from these three areas would be hydraulically dredged and disposed of landward of the high tide line in a 160,000 SF area on Rexhame Beach, located at 325 Standish Street in the Rexhame Section of Marshfield. The remaining 1,500 cubic yards of dredged material from a 15,400 SF area known as "Area Z", which is within Area A, has been determined by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection as unsuitable for beach nourishment. This material will be disposed of at an upland location, which is currently intended to be the Town of Marshfield's disposal site off of Joseph Driebeck Way.

The work is shown on the enclosed plans titled, "Plan accompanying petition of Marshfield Yacht Club, Inc. to dredge the club's boat basin and reuse the dredged material as beach nourishment at Rexhame Beach and to construct and maintain additional finger floats in the South River, Marshfield", on five sheets, and dated "June 2016". Sheet 3 of 5 was revised on "7/13/17" to show "Area Z".

Permits are required pursuant to:
x Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899
Section 404 of the Clean Water Act
Section 103 of the Marine Protection, Research and Sanctuaries Act.

The decision whether to issue a permit will be based on an evaluation of the probable impact of the proposed activity on the public interest. That decision will reflect the national concern for both protection and utilization of important resources. The benefit which may reasonably accrue from the proposal must be balanced against its reasonably foreseeable detriments. All factors which may be relevant to the proposal will be considered, including the cumulative effects thereof; among those are: conservation, economics, aesthetics, general environmental concerns, wetlands, cultural value, fish and wildlife values, flood hazards, flood plain value, land

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We are coordinating with the NMFS and/or U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service on endangered species under their jurisdiction and the ESA consultation will be concluded prior to the final decision.

COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT

The states of Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire and Rhode Island have approved Coastal Zone Management Programs. Where applicable, the applicant states that any proposed activity will comply with and will be conducted in a manner that is consistent with the approved Coastal Zone Management Program. By this Public Notice, we are requesting the State concurrence or objection to the applicant's consistency statement.

The following authorizations have been applied for, or have been, or will be obtained:

- (x) Permit, license or assent from state.
- (x) Permit from local wetland agency or conservation commission.
- (x) Water Quality Certification in accordance with Section 401 of the Clean Water Act.

COMMENTS

In order to properly evaluate the proposal, we are seeking public comment. Anyone wishing to comment is encouraged to do so. Comments should be submitted in writing by the above date. Any person may request, in writing, within the comment period specified in this notice, that a public hearing be held to consider the application. Requests for a public hearing shall specifically state the reasons for holding a public hearing. The Corps holds public hearings for the purpose of obtaining public comments when that is the best means for understanding a wide variety of concerns from a diverse segment of the public.


