This public notice is to share with the public the “STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE AQUATIC RESOURCE MITIGATION FUND, RSA Chapter 482A, FISCAL YEAR 2017 REPORT”. The in-lieu fee (ILF) program serves as an alternative form of compensation for impacts to aquatic resources authorized by the New England District Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) and/or the State of New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services.

Compensatory mitigation occurs in circumstances where a permittee is required to compensate for the functions and values of aquatic resources lost as a result of the authorization after all efforts are made to avoid and minimize impacts. ILF is an option available to the applicant instead of completing permittee-responsible mitigation. Use of the ILF program is contingent upon Corps and/or State approval.
