My name is Matthew Cartwright, and I am a student at Bristol Community College. It has come to my attention that a LNG terminal is being proposed in the Weaver's Cove area of Fall River. As I am also a member of MassPIRG, I have heard information regarding this terminal which may or may not be entirely accurate. Most of what I hear from them takes the form of a Worst-Case scenario in which an LNG leak propagates through a population center and ignites, causing mass casualties & property damage.

I however believe this event (while possible) is highly unlikely, due to various fail-safes and safety measures, the last such incident of that nature occurred not long after WW2, due to the fact that an additional tank was built more cheaply than the previous onsite tanks, without proper knowledge of how steel behaves at low temperatures. Other LNG ignitions have occurred since, but in nations such as Algeria, with lax standards, there is danger in any endeavor to better quality of life. How many died building Hoover Dam? the Golden Gate bridge? there are no perfect solutions to our energy problems, but to dismiss any solution out of hand is foolish.
