- REQUEST FOR INFORMATION
- QUESTION 1: The site visit is scheduled for Monday, June 10th. Is it possible to visit the job site this week since the scheduled site visit on Monday conflicts with another commitment?
- ANSWER 1: Please refer to PWS 3. Site Visit, "The project areas are open to the public at any time. Interested vendors can inspect the existing conditions of the work area at any time. No extra payment will be allowed for perceived additional work caused by unfamiliarity with site conditions and requirements."
- QUESTION 2: Are there available drawings to confirm the dimensions of the restrooms?
- ANSWER 2: Yes, the government possesses the manufacturer's design specifications for the restroom facility. See attachment (0Z11-03).
- QUESTION 3: Are the limits of landscaping specified for this project?
- ANSWER 3: The area to be landscaped includes all soil previously disturbed in the installation of the restroom, as well as any turf area which the contractor disturbs during execution of this PWS. The approximate extent of this area is as follows: from asphalt edge to forest line for north to south; from handicap parking spot to the west-most electrical handhole box for east to west.
- QUESTION 4: Are there specific requirements for soil compaction for the final grading?ANSWER 4: Soil shall be compacted such that normal foot traffic does not form depressions. The contractor shall not compact the soil to a point detrimental to succession of grass roots.
- QUESTION 5: The provided imagery suggests existing guardrail limits up to the west side of the restroom. Is the extension required for the guardrail identical to the one depicted?
- ANSWER 5: The existing guardrail terminates before the west face of the restroom. See PWS III. Execution, 5., "Existing guardrail shall be extended approximately 36' in a straight line along the approach roadway such that it terminates in line with the east face of the perimeter walkway of the restroom." The section spans will be identical in design, however, the terminal end of the guard rail will be flared.

- QUESTION 6: Are there drawings indicating the locations of the electrical handhole box, septic cleanouts, manholes, or any utility ports?
- ANSWER 6: No, drawings do not exist for these features. Please refer to PWS 3. Site Visit, "The project areas are open to the public at any time. Interested vendors can inspect the existing conditions of the work area at any time. No extra payment will be allowed for perceived additional work caused by unfamiliarity with site conditions and requirements."
