##### REQUEST FOR INFORMATION:

Question 1: Can you verify that brush and material can be left onsite and do not require removal from the wooded areas?

Response 1: Correct, any brush, vegetation, or other woody materials cut in the process of clearing the boundary line shall be left in the woods on US Army Corps of Engineers property. The debris shall not be left on the abutter's property and shall not be left in such a manner that it interferes with the boundary line itself.

Question 2: The scope states that the Government will supply signs and stakes as needed, and that supplies are valued at less than \$100 each. Does this mean that the contractor is responsible for reimbursing the Government for the supplies consumed?

Response 2: The supplies furnished by the Government are for the Contractor's use as required by the solicitation and resultant Purchase Order. The Contractor shall only use the signs and stakes needed, the remainder will remain in the property of the Government. The Contractor is not required to reimburse or compensate the Government in any way for these materials. When Government furnished supplies are included, the Government is required to state the value. Normally this is in the case of damage or destruction, and the Contractor is responsible for reparation to the Government.
