Edison and Woodbridge Townships and the Borough of Sayreville New Jersey – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has scheduled a public meeting to present information on the Proposed Plan for Dredge Spoil Areas 4 and 6, as well as the Proposed Plan for Area 11 and Dredge Spoil Area 2; Area 12, the Open Burn/Open Detonation Area and Dredge Spoil Area 3; Areas 16 and 16A – Munitions and Explosives of Concern in Soil at the former Raritan Arsenal, a Formerly Used Defense Site located in New Jersey. The public meeting will be held on December 17, 2025 from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. at the Edison Senior Citizen Center, 2963 Woodbridge Avenue, Edison, NJ 08837. Interested members of the public are invited to attend.
