ALTERATION OF A U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS CIVIL WORKS PROJECT PURSUANT TO 33 USC 408: MAINTENANCE DREDGING FALMOUTH HARBOR FEDERAL NAVIGATION PROJECT (FNP) FALMOUTH, MASSACHUSETTS

Interested parties are hereby notified that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, New England District (USACE) is evaluating plans under 33 U.S.C. 408 (Section 408) to conduct maintenance dredging in Falmouth Harbor proposed by Nina's Marina. The proposed dredging will be conducted within the 3:1 buffer zone of the USACE maintained Falmouth Harbor Federal Navigation Project (FNP) located at 306 Scranton Ave, Falmouth, Massachusetts. The direct impact to the FNP offset is the maintenance dredging of approximately 570 cubic yards of material from an area of approximately 11,000 square feet to a depth of -6 feet mean lower low water with a 2 foot overdredge.

This Notice is being issued pursuant to 33 U.S.C. 408 and USACE Engineering Circular (EC) 1165-2-220. Section 408 allows USACE to grant permission for the alteration, occupation, or use of a USACE civil works project if it is determined that the activity will not be injurious to the public interest and will not impair the usefulness of the Federal project. USACE has made the preliminary determination that maintenance dredging within the FNP offset will not have a negative impact on public interest, use, or our ability to maintain the Falmouth Harbor FNP. The public is invited to provide comment associated with this Section 408 evaluation.
