all parties involved. Small business utilization is just good business.

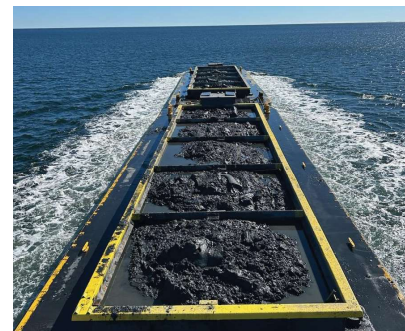
### Mission Statement:
