

We were there at the birth of our nation; USACE traces its beginnings to the opening days of the Revolutionary War when Boston native Colonel Richard Gridley was named chief engineer of the Massachusetts Volunteers and shortly thereafter, chief engineer of the newly formed Continental Army by Commander-in-Chief General George Washington. From the fortifications at Bunker Hill on June 16, 1775, to the taking of Redoubt Ten at Yorktown on Oct. 14, 1781, Army engineers played a crucial role in the war fought to make the United States a free and independent nation.

The fine tradition of service that began at Bunker Hill and inspired the new nation has continued through the years and USACE has accomplished so much and our high level of service in New England has remained unchanged. From a loosely structured organization in the first half of the 19th century, through the various districts (Boston, Providence, Portland, etc.), to the New England Division in the early 1940s and today's New England District, USACE has contributed greatly to the development and prosperity of this region.

Today we serve as a part of the North Atlantic Division. Along with our sister districts, we perform as a team to assure that the citizens of the northeastern part of the United States continue to receive the high level of service which has always been the hallmark of USACE. This total team effort allows USACE to respond wherever and whenever it is needed -- anywhere, anyplace, anytime.
