



# Internship Program Recruitment

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), New England District (NAE) is recruiting for entry-level intern positions in the civil and mechanical engineering fields as part of the **Army Career Development Program (ACDP)** during the month of November 2020. Intern positions will be posted on USAJobs <https://www.usajobs.gov> from Nov. 16 to Nov 30. This is an opportunity to join the world's premier public engineering organization, supporting our nation's civil works and military missions.

**Work:** The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, New England District delivers vital engineering and construction services that span the full breadth of USACE's civil and military missions, including environmental restoration and stewardship, flood risk management, natural resource and recreation management, streambank and shoreline protection, navigation improvements and maintenance, disaster assistance, regulatory/permitting mission, and worldwide support to the military. The New England District provides interagency support to the Environmental Protection Agency, Federal Emergency Management Agency, Housing and Urban Development, National Park Service, U.S. Customs and Border Patrol, U.S. Coast Guard, and the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs. Work is performed in an interdisciplinary team environment, working with scientists and other engineers, among a team of senior engineering and science professionals.

Applicants that are selected for the ACDP will perform a two-year internship during which time they will be placed in rotating developmental assignments working and learning in our Planning, Engineering, Regulatory, Project Management, Operations and Construction offices within the New England District. This internship will expose individuals to the many missions and skillsets of the district.

**Eligibility:** Applicants must be U.S. citizens. Applicants must have obtained a qualifying degree, or completed a qualifying career or technical education program, as determined by Office of Personnel Management, within the preceding 2 years. Veterans may be appointed within 6 years of obtaining a qualifying degree, or completing a qualifying program, if deployment prevented them from applying within the preceding 2 years.

**How to Apply:** Announcements will be posted on USAJobs <https://www.usajobs.gov>. Interested candidates should look for announcements posted by USACE Rock Island District, the recruiting cell for all Army intern positions, with a duty location in Concord, Massachusetts.

**Requirements:** Requirements may differ based on the type of positions being recruited. Please refer to the individual job announcement at the time of application to see what requirements are needed.

**Location:** The New England District Headquarters is located in historic Concord, 20 miles west of Boston, convenient to I-95, Route 3, Route 2 and Route 2A. The district also has field offices throughout the New England region.
