ALTERATION OF A U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS CIVIL WORKS PROJECT PURSUANT TO 33 USC 408: TERMINAL STRUCTURES NEW HAVEN HARBOR FEDERAL NAVIGATION PROJECT (FNP) NEW HAVEN, CONNECTICUT

Interested parties are hereby notified that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, New England District (USACE) is evaluating plans under 33 U.S.C. 408 (Section 408) to reconfigure terminal structures in New Haven Harbor proposed by Triton Terminaling, LLC. The proposed structures will be installed within the 3:1 offset of the USACE maintained 40 foot deep New Haven Harbor Federal Navigation Project (FNP) located at 481 East Shore Parkway, New Haven, Connecticut. The applicant is proposing the following work within the 120 foot FNP offset:

- Demolition Site Plans
 - Removal and disposal of a 24-foot x 26-foot shelter dolphin and ±29 timber support piles
 - Removal and disposal of a ±25 timber pile cluster
 - Removal and disposal of a 26-foot x14-foot section of abandoned dolphin 1 and ±20 steel piles
- Proposed Conditions Site Plans
 - Installation of ±350 square feet of proposed steel framed hose tower platform extension and two (2) 18-inch steel piles
 - Installation of a steel framed catwalk with no piles
 - Installation of an 8-foot x 26-foot portion of steel framed loading tower platform with three (3) 18-inch steel piles

This Notice is being issued pursuant to 33 U.S.C. 408 and USACE Engineering Circular (EC) 1165-2-220. Section 408 allows USACE to grant permission for the alteration, occupation, or use of a USACE civil works project if it is determined that the activity will not be injurious to the public interest and will not impair the usefulness of the Federal project. USACE has made the preliminary determination that the reconfiguration of terminal structures within the FNP offset will not have a negative impact on public interest, use, or our ability to maintain the New Haven Harbor FNP. The public is invited to provide comment associated with this Section 408 evaluation.
