Completed in 1943, it was the last new lighthouse commissioned in New England. It is named for President Grover Cleveland who frequently visited this area to fish, like many still do today. Safety reminder - fishing from a vessel within the shipping channel is prohibited.

SUMMARY OF SMALL CRAFT REGULATIONS

Complete Canal Regulations: Title 33 Code of Federal Regulations part 207.20

The Cape Cod Canal Project extends from Cape Cod Bay to Cleveland Ledge Light in Buzzards Bay. Vessels under 65 feet in length may enter the Canal without obtaining clearance. Vessels **65** feet in length and over shall not enter the Canal Project until clearance has been obtained from the Marine Traffic Control Center. A controller is on duty 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Vessels should call "Cape Cod Canal Control" on vhf channel 13 to establish contact. Communications will then be switched to vhf channel 12 or 14 as the working channel. All vessels regardless of size should monitor vhf channel 13 during the entire passage through the canal.

The Canal is open for passage to adequately powered vessels properly equipped and seaworthy. Sailboats are required to have and use auxiliary power during passage. Due to the strong tidal currents, low-powered vessels should await slack water or favorable current.

Canoes, kayaks, paddleboards, windsurfers and jet skis are not permitted to operate within the Canal.

The speed limit within the Canal is 10 miles per hour and no excessive wake.

Fishing and lobstering by boat in the Canal channel are prohibited. Fishing by boat is permitted in the area west of the State Pier, Buzzards Bay, provided that vessels stay out of the channel as defined by buoys and beacons.

Swimming, snorkeling and scuba diving within the Canal are prohibited.

When the Railroad Bridge is in a lowered (down) position, vessels proceeding with a fair tide are cautioned to turn and stem the current in proximity of the State Pier, Buzzards Bay or at a location approximately midway between the Bourne Highway and Railroad Bridges until the lift span is put in a raised (open) position.

Vessels within the limits of the Canal shall comply with all applicable navigation rules. Deep draft vessels passing through the Canal have the right of way. Smaller vessels shall be operated as to not interfere with navigation of larger commercial vessels. Stopping and anchoring in the Canal channel are prohibited except in emergencies. Vessels are required to notify the Marine Traffic Control Center immediately if an emergency situation has developed.

RIGHT WHALES

Right whales are the rarest whales in the world and are protected from disturbance and injury by the Endangered Species Act of 1973 and the Marine Mammal Protection Act of 1972. Because this species frequently lies at the surface, it is vulnerable to collisions with ships. In general, right whales are in the Cape Cod Bay habitat to feed between January through June.

Mariners operating in the coastal waters of the northeast United States should inform all watches to look for right whales. During nighttime and other periods of reduced visibility, vessel operators should use the slowest safe speed for navigation to reduce the risk of collisions with the whales.

Adult right whales are medium in size and are 45 to 55 feet long. Calves are 15 to 20 feet long and are usually with their mothers. Right whales have distinct “V” shaped blows, no dorsal fin, short and broad flippers, and deeply notched tail flukes with smooth trailing edges. Right whales have black skin with rough patches of skin or callosities on their head.

ACTIONS TO PROTECT RIGHT WHALES AND OTHER WHALES:

- In an effort to avoid collisions, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Marine Traffic Controllers will alert shippers of right whale locations as reported to them by the National Marine Fisheries Service. Sighting reports are weather and resource dependent and do not necessarily represent the location of all right whales.
- Avoid excessive speed or sudden changes in speed or direction when in sight of whale(s) less than 1,500 feet away.
- It is illegal to approach a right whale within 500 yards. A 500 yard buffer zone must be maintained between the vessel and the right whale. A vessel must depart immediately from the buffer zone created by the surfacing of a right whale.

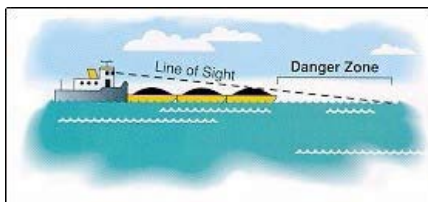

Cape Cod Canal - OPERATION SAFE TRANSIT

Small boats must always KEEP CLEAR of ships.

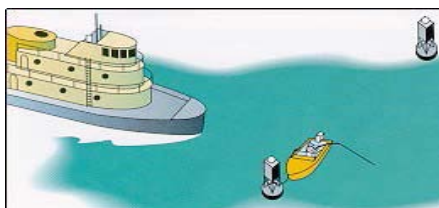
- STAY CLEAR of large marine traffic such as tankers, cruise ships and tug and barge combinations.
- Once a large commercial vessel enters the Canal it is unable to stop due to the narrow channel limits and swift currents.
- Due to their size, large commercial vessels are unable to quickly maneuver to avoid a collision. Stay clear!
- Large commercial ships have a blind spot directly in front of their bow that can extend for hundreds of feet. This danger zone should be avoided at all times.



OBSTRUCTING NAVIGATION WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CAPE COD CANAL IS PROHIBITED

The following are obstructions to navigation:

- Fishing
- Stopping
- Anchoring
- Unnecessarily idling at a low speed
- Low powered vessels not making adequate headway



NAVIGATION RULE # 9 IT'S THE LAW!

States as follows:

- (a) A vessel proceeding along the course of a narrow channel or fairway shall keep as near to the outer limit of the channel or fairway which lies on her starboard side as is safe and practicable.
- (b) A vessel of less than 20 meters in length or a sailing vessel shall not impede the passage of a vessel *that* can safely navigate only within a narrow channel or fairway.
- (c) A vessel engaged in fishing shall not impede the passage of any other vessel navigating within a narrow channel or fairway.
- (d) A vessel shall not cross a narrow channel or fairway if such crossing impedes the passage of a vessel which can safely navigate only within such channel or fairway.

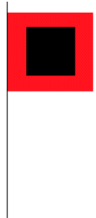

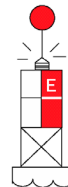
