## Know before you go...

Here's what's currently open, closed and in-effect at the Cape Cod Canal

- ✓ Service Roads & Recreation Areas are OPEN for recreation
  - Portable toilets are available in some locations. Cleaned 3x/week
  - Trash receptacles are available at parking areas
  
- ✓ Restrooms are open daily:
  - Buzzards Bay, Herring Run, Sagamore, Sandcatcher, Tidal Flats & Bourne Recreation Areas from April 24 - October 11
  - Midway Recreation Area from May 28 - September 6
  - ✗ - Sandwich Recreation Area restrooms are CLOSED for repairs until further notice. Portable toilets are available near the building. Cleaned 1x/day.
  
- ✗ The Cape Cod Canal Visitor Center is OPEN with a LIMITED schedule
  - ✓ - Starting July 3: Open Thursdays and Saturdays from 10am - 5pm
  - ✓ - Additional outdoor programs and activities scheduled this summer can be found using the links or email below.
