Know before you go...

Here's what's currently open, closed and in-effect at the Cape Cod Canal

- ✓ Service Roads & Recreation Areas are OPEN for recreation
 - Portable toilets are available in some locations. Cleaned 3x/week
 - Trash receptacles are available at parking areas
 - Pack out your trash in locations where receptacles are not available
- ✓ Restrooms:
 - Buzzards Bay, Herring Run, Sagamore, Sandcatcher, Tidal Flats & Bourne Recreation Areas: OPEN Daily April 23 - October 12
 - Midway Recreation Area: OPEN Daily May 27 - October 12
 - ✗ - Sandwich Recreation Area restrooms are CLOSED for repairs until further notice. Portable toilets are available near the building. Cleaned 1x/day.
- ✓ The Cape Cod Canal Visitor Center is OPEN May 3 - Oct 22
 - HOURS: Tuesday - Saturday from 10am-5pm
 - In July & August: also OPEN on Sundays
 - Admission: FREE!
