

How Do I Apply For A Park Attendant Position At The Cape Cod Canal?

Park Attendants are paid contractors hired by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to work seasonally from April to October at the Cape Cod Canal. Park Attendant contractors receive monetary compensation as well as a free campsite in exchange for their work. In order to apply, you must:

1. Apply for a Dun & Bradstreet number.
 - a. This is a 9 digit identification number which is FREE for all businesses required to register with the federal government for contracts.
 - b. You may request a number at: <https://fedgov.dnb.com/webform> OR call 1-866-705-5711
 - c. This process typically takes 1-2 business days

 2. Register your business with Sam.Gov. Sam.Gov is the System for Award Management database.
 - a. You will need your Dun & Bradstreet number to register with Sam.Gov.
 - b. Sam.Gov is FREE. Beware of scams from third party vendors offering to register you for payment. Make sure you are on the secure and official site.
 - c. You can register at: <https://www.sam.gov> OR call 1-866-606-8220
 - d. This process typically takes 3-5 days after the IRS validates your taxpayer ID number
- Please note that the Canal cannot assist you with Dun & Bradstreet or Sam.Gov. If you have questions or experience difficulties, please call the appropriate telephone number listed above.
