Know before you go...

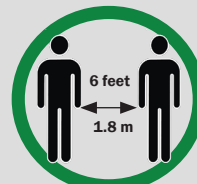
Here's what's currently open, closed and in-effect at the Cape Cod Canal

- ✓ Service Roads & Recreation Areas are OPEN for recreation
 - Portable toilets are available. Cleaned 3x/week
 - Trash receptacles are available at parking areas
- ! Surfaces like picnic tables, benches & railings are not routinely cleaned
- ✓ Restrooms will be open with reduced hours at:
 - Buzzards Bay, Herring Run, Sagamore, Sandcatcher, Tidal Flats & Bourne Recreation Areas from April 24 - October 11
 - Midway Recreation Area from May 29 - September 6
- ✗ The Cape Cod Canal Visitor Center is CLOSED for the 2021 season
- ✗ Sandwich Recreation Area restrooms are CLOSED for repairs until further notice. Portable toilets are available near the building

While at the Cape Cod Canal, please adhere to all CDC and Massachusetts guidance and advisories to reduce the spread of COVID-19. Remember Safety is our number one priority.
