Know before you go...

Here's what's currently open, closed and in-effect at the Cape Cod Canal.

- χ Midway Recreation Area is CLOSED for the season.
- ✓ All other recreation areas, service roads & access to shoreline fishing are OPEN.
- X Flush toilets, sinks and water fountains remain CLOSED until further notice.
- ✓ Portable toilets are available at all developed recreation areas. Cleaned 3x/week.
- χ The Visitor Center is CLOSED for the 2020 season.
- X In-person programs and special events are suspended until further notice. Special Event permits are not being issued at this time.
- \checkmark Trash receptacles are OPEN. Properly dispose of all trash, including pet waste.
 - Surfaces such as picnic tables, benches & railings are not routinely cleaned.

While at the Cape Cod Canal, please adhere to all CDC and Massachusetts guidance and advisories to reduce the spread of COVID-19. Remember **Safety** is our **number one priority.**



Stay home if you feel sick.

Wear a face covering. Avoid touching your eyes, nose & mouth.



Practice social distancing. Avoid gathering in groups of 10 or more.

Wash hands with soap often, for at least 20 seconds. Use hand sanitizer when sinks are not available.
