Know before you go...

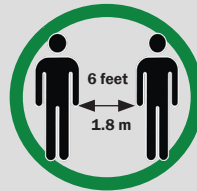
Here's what's currently open, closed and in-effect at the Cape Cod Canal

- ✗ The following are CLOSED for the season:
 - All flush toilets, sinks and water fountains
 - The Cape Cod Canal Visitor Center
 - Midway Recreation Area
- ✓ The service roads and all access areas remain OPEN for recreation
 - A limited number of trash receptacles are available at the parking areas
 - Properly dispose of all trash, including pet waste
 - Portable toilets are available at Buzzards Bay, Herring Run, Sagamore, Sandwich & Tidal Flats Recreation Areas. Cleaned 2x/week.
- ! Surfaces such as picnic tables, benches & railings are not routinely cleaned
- ✗ In-person programs and special events are suspended until further notice

While at the Cape Cod Canal, please adhere to all CDC and Massachusetts guidance and advisories to reduce the spread of COVID-19. Remember Safety is our number one priority.
