Here's what's currently open, closed and in-effect at the Cape Cod Canal

- ✓ Service Roads & Recreation Areas are OPEN for recreation*
- ✗ Restrooms and water fountains are CLOSED for the season
- ✓ Portable toilets are available at:
 - Buzzards Bay, Herring Run, Sagamore, Tidal Flats, Bourne, Sandwich & Sandcatcher Recreation Areas -
 - Cleaned 3x/week
- ✗ All trash receptacles are CLOSED for the season.
- ✓ Pack it in. Pack it out policy is in effect along the entire Canal.
- ✗ The Cape Cod Canal Visitor Center is CLOSED for the season
