## Safety:

Mike Cunningham reported that there were no safety issues to date.

### Work Accomplished Since Last Meeting (as of 9/5/2019):

- 16" DIP and fittings for start-up delivered and are onsite.
- Started installation of 16" DIP on South Main Street, Middletown.
- Excavated "Test Hole" at intersection of South Main Street and Talcott Ridge Drive in Middletown. "Conflict" with existing 12" DI Water Main.

Jon Pio said that approximately 500 LFT of 16" DIP has been installed

## Other Issues to be Discussed:

• Delivery and tracking of Notification Letters to Residents.

Ed mentioned that we need to track when these notifications have been delivered including dates, type of notifications (i.e.) Mail- hand delivery. Ed mentioned that Mike C. needs to look at the dates and revise letters due to the push back on the Start Date for Talcott Ridge Drive. Mike C. to develop resident contact sheet.

Ed needs to contact Laura Francis about this issue. Town of Durham Fair Committee must give their approval prior. Ed will have an answer either way by days end on Friday, September 13, 2019.

# New Items:

- S. Dunbar explained stakeholder web site is up. Will share link with all.
- Additional Connection at Talcott Ridge Drive and South Main Street due to the conflict with the existing 12" water main. A solid sleeve will need to be installed.
- Moving Water Service location at # 2155 South Main Street. Ludlow would like to move the location out of the driveway. A discussion ensued about not installing the curb stops and boxes on the residences that have not signed the Property Access forms. Rob B. would like these to be installed now rather than later when the new asphalt will have to be re-excavated. Rob asked Ed if Middletown could install these or hire Ludlow to do. ED explained that EPA is not a municipality and has no easement rites to do this work under their contract. Ed will look into Robs question.
- Ed asked about the hydrant relocation. Rich B. said he already submitted new detail, not in conformed specs.
- Eversource Gas: Greg May attended the meeting representing Eversource. He said that they do not have depths on their gas main but the only deviations in depths would be at the drainage crossings. Greg left some drawings for Ludlow's use in the trailer. Greg also point out that id Ludlow plans on using a mole for the water services they need to expose the gas line and bore under away from the gas main.
- Rich B. asked Greg if he could supply any as-built drawings for the culvert crossing on Pickett Lane. Greg will get back to Rich.
- Ed asked if a contingency plan was in place if we hit the gas main? Both Jon Pio and Greg said yes. Call 911.
- Ed asked that we synch with Eversource schedule so we are not working in the same area. Greg said he would try to attend some of these meetings.
- All agreed that Mike C. will submit Bi-weekly progress report on Wednesday with the two-week look ahead, stakeholders' comment at Thursday's meeting, Mike C. finalizes Thursday pm, posted to Website on Friday's.
