Once the hole was excavated they Fabric was placed in the bottom of the

excavation followed by 6" of 3/4" stone. Then the stone was covered with fabric. They then placed 3" of sand, installed the pipe and placed 12"of sand over the pipe followed by 3 - 12" lifts of native material or processed gravel where they encountered unsuitable material and compacted each lift. Placed 2 - 8" lifts of processed gravel and compacted each lift. Finally placed 4" of HMA in two 2" compacted lifts.

No water was encountered in the trench today.

A state police officer was positioned at end of the worksite.

Compaction Tests today - Yes, Observed John Turner Consulting performing the compaction tests. All of the tests were above the required 95%.

Drove by the storage during my shift. Observation made both times was no material was spilled on the ground and no damage to asphalt. The catch basin did have sediment control fabric in it and did not appear to be clogged.

Follow up inspection of the curb stop installations on route 17 in Durham. Curb stops are being installed per the drawings.
