A press conference will be held Monday, May 13 to commemorate the signing of an Interagency Agreement for Fort Devens and the Fort Devens Sudbury Training Annex. The U.S. Army and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency will sign the agreement which outlines the roles, responsibilities, and schedules for the investigation and cleanup of Superfund hazardous waste areas at the installations.
