## **Synopsis**

On Friday, July 24, 2020 at approximately 1730hrs Sgt Rogowski and Tpr Jones responded to the area of 80 Hospital Road, Devens for two items of possible military ordnance. Upon arrival Tpr Jones met with C-9 SP Devens patrol and Devens FD. A civilian male immediately stated to Tpr Jones that he had used a magnet from a kayak on the Nashua River in an effort to find a "musket" he located two items in the water that appeared to be military ordnance. Tpr Jones donned ppe. Upon inspection the items (see attached photos) were heavily deteriorated by corrosion from being underwater for some time. X-ray diagnostics and consult with Tpr Rockett determined that the items were a MK-2 "Pineapple" Hand Grenade with severely corroded fuzing present and a 60 mm Mortar. Both items were deemed safe to transport to a disposal site but in need of immediate disposal. The items were transported to the Devens DPW pit on Cook Street and disposed of without incident.

The subject in question was advised to discontinue his endeavors at least in the area of the Devens area due to the presence of military ordnance.
